**Notes:**

1. All Sundays are Holy Days in which we are obliged to participate in the Mass (or Saturday evening). Lessons are important but participating in Mass is more important. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Commandment is: **Keep Holy the Lord’s Day**. If you can’t go to both Mass and Faith Formation, go to Mass.
2. **Parent sessions are on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sundays each month and April 26 in 7<sup>th</sup> grade classroom.**
3. Faith Formation is provided to assist parents in raising their children to know, love, and serve God. Parents are the primary teachers of their children and our process includes lessons for parents to teach at home. These lessons are important and provide the added benefit of refreshing your own knowledge of Catholic Teaching, deepening your Faith, strengthening your bond with your children, and better equipping you to help your family, friends, & neighbors experience a deeper relationship with Christ.
4. When Sacrament Preparation lessons are missed arrangements are made to make up lesson.
